**ORDER EXTENDING THE EXCLUSIVE PERIOD FOR THE DEBTOR  
TO OBTAIN ACCEPTANCES FOR ITS PLAN OF REORGANIZATION  
(The NEG T Debtor)**

Upon consideration of the Debtor’s motion for entry of an order extending the exclusive period for the Debtor to obtain acceptances for its proposed plan of reorganization (the “Motion”) filed by National Energy & Gas Transmission, Inc., f/k/a PG&E National Energy Group, Inc. (“NEG” or the “Debtor”), one of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the “Debtors”), and after consideration of any objections made thereto and after any hearing held thereon; and it appearing that adequate notice of the Motion was provided and that no further or other notice is necessary; and there appearing good cause for

granting the relief requested in the Motion; it is by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland, hereby

**ORDERED**, that the Motion be and the same is hereby GRANTED; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that all capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Motion; and it is further

**ORDERED**, pursuant to section 1121(d) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtors' Exclusive Solicitation Period, with respect to the NEGT Plan and any amendments or modifications thereto, is hereby extended to and including May 5, 2004; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that this Order is without prejudice to the right of the Debtors' right to request further extensions of the Exclusive Solicitation Period pursuant to section 1121(d) of the Bankruptcy Code.
